

Paul's Opening Prayer: Part 1 – Thanksgiving
Philippians 1:3-8

- Paul expresses thankfulness to God for the Philippian Church. (1:3-5)
  - A. He gave thanks to God for thankful memories.
  - B. He was filled with thanksgiving and joy because of the Philippian's ongoing partnership in the Gospel.

## Do you have a thankful mindset?

- II. Paul expresses thankful confidence that God will accomplish His work in their lives. (1:6-7)
  - A. He believed God would finish the work He began at salvation through sanctification.
  - B. He whole-heartedly loved these Christians.

C. He believed that God's grace is powerful to completely sanctify His children, regardless of any earthly obstacles they might face.

## Do you have a confident mindset?

- III. Paul expresses thankful compassion for the Philippian Church. (1:8)
  - A. His compassion for them was genuine and undeniable.
  - B. He loved them with an *affection* that only Christ can give and create. (Philippians 2:1)
    - Matthew 9:36; 14:14; 15:32; 18:27; 20:34
    - Mark 1:41; 6:34; 8:2
    - Luke 7:13; 10:33; 15:20
