Thinking Correctly about Life and Death: Part 2

Philippians 1:22-26

Christians must approach both life and death in a way that spiritually encourages others.

- I. Paul shares his personal conflict in approaching life and death. (1:22-24)
 - A. Paul's conflict *initially* left him **unsure.** (vs. 22)
 - B. Paul's conflict included his **desires.** (vs. 23)
 - C. Paul's conflict included his **brothers and sisters in Christ.** (vs. 24)
- II. Paul shares his personal commitment in approaching life and death. (1:25-26)
 - A. He was committed to glorifying **Jesus Christ.**
 - B. He was committed to the spiritual growth of **others.**
 - 1. This should impact our perspective towards **discipleship**.
 - 2. This should impact our perspective towards evangelism.
 - 3. This should impact our perspective towards worship.

Application

- 1. Do not feel guilty about struggling in approaching both life and death.
- 2. Embrace the struggle of approaching life and death with a heart and mindset of worship.
- 3. Rejoice in the fact that God will help you spiritually encourage others as you approach both life and death! (Philippians 4:13)
