

The Holiness of God's Light

Daniel 2:20-22

Context of *Daniel 2*

- The king of Babylon has a very troubling dream (**vs. 1**)
- The king gives an impossible and cruel command (**vs. 2-11**)
- Daniel and his friends are condemned to die (**vs. 12-15**)
- Daniel receives a request for additional time (**vs. 16**)
- Daniel and his friends pray for God's mercy (**vs. 17-18**)
- God reveals to Daniel both the dream and its meaning (**vs. 19**)
- Daniel blesses and thanks the God of Heaven (**vs. 20-23**)
- Daniel reveals the mystery of the dream to the king (**vs. 24-45**)
- Daniel and his friends are promoted by the king (**vs. 46-49**)

Our passage this morning is filled with rich, eternal truths about God's character, attributes, and actions towards humanity.

The **holiness** of God is a core reality that overshadows all of His divine character traits, attributes, and actions.

This morning we are going to look at three realities about God working in our salvation through His Son, Jesus Christ, who is the Light of the World:
