



# OBSERVATION


When we **obey** God's Word *in times of discouragement and weariness*, He enables us to be filled with **worshipful awe** of His glory and power.

2. Are you struggling with **weariness** because of the non-stop busyness of life or because of the darkness that pervades this world?



# QUESTIONS

3. Are you struggling with being **overwhelmed** with fear or concern over the trials that are present or ahead of you?



# OBSERVATION

Jesus experienced discouragement, weariness, and overwhelmingness on a cosmic and **unprecedented** level as the holy Son of God.

2. When you are struggling with **weariness**, run to Christ and to His Word—and follow His commands.




# APPLICATION


