The Tragic Entry of the King Luke 19:41-48

In our passage this morning we can see **three reasons** why Jesus Christ's entry into Jerusalem was *tragic*:

I. Jesus Christ's entry into Jerusalem was tragic because the people of Jerusalem were looking for the wrong kind of ______ and their judgment was near. (19:41-44)

II. Jesus Christ's entry into Jerusalem was tragic because the people of Jerusalem were participating in the wrong kind of ______ and their transgression was blatant. (19:45-46)

III. Jesus Christ's entry into Jerusalem was tragic because the leaders of Jerusalem were both _____ God's Son and were seeking to _____ the only One who could save them. (19:47-48)

BIG IDEA: Those who fail to believe the truth about Jesus Christ will lose everything.

Observations

- People all around us continue to look for the wrong kind of peace—and their judgment is near.
- People all around us (included many professing "Christians") continue to participate in the wrong kind of worship—and their transgression is blatant.
- Many of our leaders (including many professing "Christians") are rejecting God's Word and its teaching about Jesus Christ and how eternal salvation is a gift from God that cannot be earned by good works.

Implications & Application

- 1. **True peace** with God is only found through saving faith in Jesus Christ.
- True worship of God is only found through believing God's Word and obeying God's Word as He has revealed it in His holy Scriptures.
- Do not be deceived and led astray by those who would lead you away from trusting in and obeying God's Word.
- 4. Instead of having a fickle and blind faith, be a true disciple of Jesus Christ by having a Scripture-driven faith that makes Jesus Christ the Source of your peace, the Object of your worship, and the Delight of your soul.
