## The Triumphant Resurrection of the King (Luke 24)

## Narrative:

- **24:1-9** The truth about the miracle of Jesus Christ's resurrection was revealed from Heaven to some of His disciples. These ladies became some of His first converts by faith in His resurrection!
- **24:10-12** While these ladies fully believed Heaven's good news about Jesus Christ, His future apostles refused to believe what they could not see when it was shared with them.
- **24:13-35** Jesus Christ graciously appeared to two of His disciples and enabled them to understand the Scriptures concerning His death, burial, and resurrection. They recognized Jesus and fully believed in the good news of His resurrection!
- **24:36-49** Jesus Christ graciously revealed Himself to "the eleven" disciples and "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures." They finally (and fully) believed in the gospel of His resurrection!
- **24:50-52** After Jesus Christ ascended to Heaven, His newly-saved disciples were filled with joy and boldness as they went forward in telling others about the good news of His salvation.

**BIG IDEA of Luke 24:** Those who fully believe the truth about Jesus Christ's resurrection are forever changed!

**Exposition/Sermon:** This morning we will briefly examine **four gifts that we receive** when we <u>fully believe</u> in the truth about Jesus Christ's resurrection:
