Four truths about the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

- I. **The resurrection of Jesus Christ sets Christianity _____ from all religions. (17:16-31)**
 - A. Christianity worships our _____ God instead of worshiping His creation. (vs. 16, 24-27)
 - B. Christianity believes and preaches the _____, which declares that the Son of God came to Earth, died in our place, and was raised to life. (vs. 18; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
 - C. Christianity believes and preaches that God's _____ is available to all by _____ in Jesus Christ alone, apart from any "good works." (vs. 30)
 - D. Christianity believes and preaches that God's holy _____ and _____ for sin is eternal. (vs. 30-31)

- II. The resurrection of Jesus Christ confirms God's future _____ on this world. (17:30-31)
- III. The resurrection of Jesus Christ sets Christians _____ from non-Christians (or "unbelievers"). (17:32-33)
- IV. The resurrection of Jesus Christ continues to change everything for those who _____ and _____ God's command to, "Repent." (17:34)
