BIG IDEA: Because every one of us has sinned, the Mosaic Law is powerless to save us from sin's curse and penalty.

In preparation for Communion:

- 2. **Rejoice** in the power of Jesus Christ's victory over sin and death as He rose from the dead—never more to die and forevermore alive.

- 4. **Worship** Jesus Christ with thankful awe as you remember how He willingly shed His blood and gave His body to be killed for your sin—so that you might know His forgiveness and love by faith.
