It will be **counted** to us who **believe** in Him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, <sup>25</sup> who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our **justification**. <sup>5:1</sup> Therefore, since we have been **justified by faith...** 

**BIG IDEA:** There is nothing better (or more important) than being justified by God through faith in Jesus Christ.

## Application

- 1. <u>If you are a Christian</u>, **rejoice and rest** in the <u>peace</u>, <u>grace</u>, and <u>hope</u> that you have in God as your Heavenly Father.
- If you are not a Christian, then you are at war with God, have not tasted of God's saving grace, and you are without hope, and your father is the Devil (John 8:44-45).

- Agree with God and admit your sin/depravity!
- Repent of (turn away from) your sin by believing in Jesus Christ alone for salvation.
- Forever receive God's gift of salvation and justification through faith in Jesus Christ alone!
