***BIG IDEA from 12:11-21:** Christians must keep loving one another, even in the most difficult ministry scenarios or relationship struggles.*

***BIG IDEA from 13:1-10:** The goal of Christian discipline and restoration must always be the glory of God through spiritual edification.*
