

Immediate Context

Romans 5:1-11

- 5:12-14 The Dreadful Reign of Death through Adam's <u>Sin</u>
- **5:15-17** The Free Gift of God's Righteousness through His <u>Grace</u>
- **5:18-21** The Glorious Reign of Grace through Jesus Christ's <u>Obedience</u>

BIG IDEA:


Adam's sin put all humanity under sin's curse of death.

Exposition

I. A real man named Adam really rebelled and sinned against God's clear command. (5:12a)

Observation

If you deny the historicity of the teachings of God's Word about Adam, then you have no reason or basis to believe any other Scripture passages or persons as true (i.e., Jesus Christ!).



Application

When faced with the option of one over the other, always believe in God's Holy Word over the words of sinful man.

BIG IDEA:

Adam's sin put all humanity under sin's curse of death.

Exposition

 When sin entered the world through Adam's rebellion against God's Word, death also entered this world as God's holy punishment and curse against sin. (5:12b)

Observations

God always keeps His promises and His Word is always true.

Observations

It would not be right or "fair" for God to allow sin to go unpunished.

Observations

Death now comes to every human being at divinely appointed times because of Adam's sin, not because of unfairness or injustice with God.

Application

Beware of blaming God for the dreadful fruits of sin that we see all around us and experience (death, pain, illness, famine, sorrow, etc.).

BIG IDEA:

Adam's sin put all humanity under sin's curse of death.

Exposition

III. Adam's willful rebellion and transgression against God's Word (aka "sin") caused death to spread and reign over all of Adam's depraved, sinning, and condemned descendants. (5:12c)

Application

Praise God that where Adam disobeyed and failed with dreadful consequences, Jesus Christ obeyed fully and triumphed with glorious benefits to those who believe in Him!
