Review from Last Week

- **1.** A real man named <u>Adam</u> really rebelled and sinned against God's clear command. **(5:12a)**
- **2.** When sin entered the world through Adam's rebellion against God's Word, <u>death</u> also entered this world as God's holy punishment and curse against sin. **(5:12b)**
- **3.** Adam's willful rebellion and transgression against God's Word caused <u>death</u> to spread and reign over all of Adam's depraved, sinning, and condemned descendants. **(5:12c)**

Observations:

- Each one of us has a decision to make—will we choose life or will we choose to remain under sin's curse of death?
- Jesus Christ came as the perfect Son of God—the "second Adam"—and He defeated sin and death with His innocent death and His victory over death.

BIG IDEA: Jesus Christ is far greater than Adam!

Application:

- If you are still under the curse of sin and are an enemy of God, do not resist His free gift of salvation any longer. (5:15-16; 6:23; 10:9-13)
- If you are a Christian, praise God for His free gift of eternal life and live for His glory by learning to say "No!" to sin like Jesus Christ did.
