Observations

- Spirit-empowered Christian living is <u>not</u> mysterious and is <u>not</u> just for "elite saints."
- Spirit-empowered Christian living is <u>not</u> impossible for true, born-again, biblical Christians.
- Spirit-empowered Christian living is <u>not</u> just possible for every Christian—it is mandated and it will happen.
- Spirit-empowered Christian living does <u>not</u> happen without the active obedience of Christians to the Word and Spirit of God.

- 1. **Read** God's Word and learn to **meditate** on its truths with a heart and mind that are ready to **obey** His truth.
- Ask God to help you to obey the Holy Spirit's leading and commands to "put to death" the sinful deeds of your body.
