## **IMPLICATIONS/APPLICATION**

- The responsibility of man to choose to <u>believe</u> in Jesus Christ is part of God's sovereign salvation plan. (It is not a secondary consideration or in conflict with God's sovereign election.)
- Those who are offended by Jesus Christ will be put to shame if they refuse to <u>believe</u> in Him for salvation.
- Do not reject Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord.
  <u>Believe</u> on Him and worship Him as your Savior and Lord—and you will be saved!
