## "Anyone who believes in Jesus Christ alone for salvation will be saved."

- Because we are sinners, we are <u>unable</u> to save ourselves from God's righteous wrath.
- God will forgive and justify us if we <u>believe</u> and obey His Word through faith.
- The nation of Israel's ongoing <u>unbelief</u> in Jesus Christ is a clear fulfillment of God's Old Testament prophecies.

**Big Idea:** Christians must unashamedly proclaim the truth of God's righteousness.
