

## The Necessity of Faith in Salvation: Part 2

**Romans 10:1-4** (p. #946 in pew Bible)

Review from last Sunday (9:30-33):

**“Anyone who believes in Jesus Christ alone for salvation will be saved.”**

- Because we are sinners, we are **unable** to save ourselves from God’s righteous wrath.
- God will forgive and justify us if we **believe** and obey His Word through **faith**.
- The nation of Israel’s ongoing **unbelief** in Jesus Christ is a clear fulfillment of God’s Old Testament prophecies.

**Big Idea:** Christians must unashamedly proclaim the truth of God’s righteousness.

- I. As Christians, we must pray for God to \_\_\_\_\_ the lost around us. (10:1-2)
  - Christians must not *cut corners* in sharing the Gospel for the sake of personal \_\_\_\_\_ or perceived \_\_\_\_\_.
  - Christians must not “*coin clip*” God’s truth by ignoring or \_\_\_\_\_ any truths of the Gospel.
  - Christians must not *confuse* the unsaved by preaching a false gospel that \_\_\_\_\_ zeal (or \_\_\_\_\_) over the true knowledge of God’s righteousness by faith.
  - Christians must not *cheat* the unsaved by preaching a false gospel that \_\_\_\_\_ the contours and boundaries of the Gospel in favor of \_\_\_\_\_ acceptance or human \_\_\_\_\_.

- Christians must not *contradict* the Gospel by \_\_\_\_\_ the holy righteousness of Jesus Christ.

## II. \_\_\_\_\_ of God's righteousness always leads to eternal condemnation. (10:3)

- God never \_\_\_\_\_ or blesses human ignorance of His righteousness.
- Both the intentional and the unintentional \_\_\_\_\_ of God's righteousness have the same terrible ending.
- Ignorance of God's righteousness gives rise to a false, man-centered view of \_\_\_\_\_.
- Ignorance of God's righteousness gives rise to a false, \_\_\_\_\_ worship that refuses to submit to God.

## III. Jesus Christ imparts His righteous to \_\_\_\_\_ who \_\_\_\_\_ in Him alone for salvation. (10:4)

- Only Jesus Christ can give us the righteousness that Israel could not attain by \_\_\_\_\_ failing to obey God's Law.
