

The Righteous Inclusivity of the Gospel

Romans 10:5-13 (p. #946 in pew Bible)

Big Idea: *Everyone who by faith calls on the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation will be saved.*

Immediate Context:

- **10:1-3** – Paul again shares his heart and prayer focus for the salvation of his fellow Israelites. He laments the ongoing spiritual blindness of Israel as a nation because of their refusal to submit to God’s righteousness by faith in Jesus Christ—their true Messiah.
- **10:4** – Paul boldly declares that Jesus Christ has put an end to the Old Testament Mosaic Law and that His righteousness is imparted to “**everyone** who believes” in Him by faith for salvation.

Summary of Passage:

- **10:5-8** – Paul supports his statement in verse 4 by contrasting “righteousness that is based on the (Mosaic, Old Testament) Law” with “righteousness based on faith.”
- **10:9-10** – Paul details the necessary elements that cause a condemned sinner to be converted to a saved Christian.
- **10:11-13** – Paul uses Scriptural support in declaring that anyone, regardless of their ethnicity, can be saved from sin’s condemnation through faith in Jesus Christ.
