

God's Sovereign Plan for Israel's Salvation: Part 3

Romans 11:13-24

(p. #947 in pew Bible)

Big Idea: *God has not rejected the nation of Israel.*

Implication: Gentile (or “non-Jewish”) Christians must not be arrogant towards Israel or prideful towards themselves.

- I. _____ or sinful _____ should never take root in the heart of Christians, especially towards Israel. **(11:13-18)**

Observation:

The **antidote** for arrogant boasting (towards Israel) is **remembering** that God doesn't need us—**we need God!**

Application:

Instead of acting sinfully towards the nation of Israel because of their faults and failures, we must instead **look to God** and **place our full dependency in Him.**

How?!

By remembering and resting in God's **undeserved kindness** and **sustaining nourishment** towards us.

II. _____ should never take root in the heart of Christians, especially prideful _____ in ourselves. **(11:19-24)**

Observation:

The **antidote** for pride and self-boasting is **the fear of the Lord.**

Application:

Instead of boasting in ourselves,
we must **live in fearful awe of God.**

How?!

By marveling and meditating
on God's **undeserved kindness** and **severe judgment.**
