Application:

Instead of acting sinfully towards the nation of Israel because of their faults and failures, we must instead **look to God** and **place our full dependency in Him.**

How?!

By remembering and resting in God's **undeserved kindness** and **sustaining nourishment** towards us.

Observation:

The **antidote** for pride and self-boasting is **the fear of the Lord.**

Application:

Instead of boasting in ourselves, we must live in fearful awe of God.

How?!

By marveling and meditating on God's **undeserved kindness** and **severe judgment.**
