 - Growing, maturing, and deepening in our love for God and for others is a lifelong reality of the Christian life.
 - John Calvin on Paul's salvation and sanctification: "The wolf became a sheep and then a shepherd."
 - John Calvin on pastors: "A pastor needs two voices, one for gathering the sheep and the other for driving away wolves and thieves."

Observations and Application

- 1. Jesus Christ lovingly, willingly, and sacrificially gave His life for us so that we could come to true salvation through faith in Him.
 - Romans 5:1-8
- 2. Following Jesus means that we must obey His call to love one another—just as He loved us—with sacrificial love.
 - John 15:13-17

- 3. Nothing will separate Christians from the love of God.
 - Romans 8:35-39
- 4. Christians must never let circumstances or people separate them from God's call to love their neighbor for God's glory.

- 5. Loving one's neighbor also includes showing God's holy love to all government leaders and political candidates.

- 6. Genuinely ask God to help you to biblically love others—and get ready to see Him answer that prayer!
