Implication: Christians who are "stronger" on an issue must lovingly "build up" Christians who are "weaker" on the same issue with a spirit of sacrificial endurance and encouragement.

Application: Pursue **Christlike harmony and humility** with other Christians for the glory of God.

Implication: Christians who are "stronger" on an issue must lovingly serve Christians who are "weaker" on the same issue with a spirit of sacrificial joy and peace.

Application: Pursue **Christlike faith and hope** with other Christians for the glory of God.

BIG IDEA: When you disagree with a brother or sister in Christ, sacrificially pursue the glory of God and their good.
