Note the **3** "according to" statements that help in structuring and developing this closing doxology:

- The "strengthening/establishing" that God gives to His Church is "according to" the Gospel of Jesus Christ. (vs. 25; 1:11-12)
- The "preaching of Jesus Christ" is "according to" the openly manifested "revelation" of God. (vs. 25; 1:1-6, 18-21; 3:19-26; 5:6)
- This openly manifested "revelation" from God is "according to" the "command of the eternal God." (vs. 26)

 - B. The divine _____ of the Gospel of Jesus Christ must be clearly revealed to every nation (or "ethnic people group").

BIG IDEA: God will powerfully strengthen Christians and local churches who correctly apply His Gospel to their daily lives.

Observations

- The Epistle to the Romans focuses on both clarifying the Gospel of Jesus Christ and applying it to the Christian life.
- At Communion, we remember Jesus Christ's substitutional death on the cross to pay the penalty of death for our sin. (Romans 3:10, 23; 5:8-9)
- Only those who believe and obey the Gospel of Jesus Christ will be allowed into God's eternal Kingdom. (Romans 3:23-25; 6:23; 9:10-15)
- Through obedient faith in the Gospel of Jesus Christ, Christians are declared righteous by God and are called to "live by faith." (Romans 1:17)
