BIG IDEA: Reconciliation with God produces Christian unity.

Observations

- 1.** It is good for Christians to remember their former situation as unreconciled sinners so that they can think and live more correctly as those who have been reconciled to God (in Christ).
- 2.** Jesus Christ has broken down every wall of hostility between Jewish and Gentile Christians.
- 3.** Every Christian is given full and immediate access to God the Father through the indwelling Holy Spirit.
- 4.** Jesus Christ is the Head over every aspect of His Church.
- 5.** Christian unity requires Christ-centered humility, thankfulness, and personal responsibility.
- 6.** The Church of Jesus Christ should be the humblest, the most thankful, and the most responsible people group in the entire world.
- 7.** God has designed the Church of Jesus Christ to be growing and maturing in Christian unity.
